Amateur men	(19 - 34 years, born 2005 - 1990)
Master men	(35 years and above, born 1989 and earlier)

*U13 boys/girls is an open category, uniting boys and girls with license and daily license. The competition also concludes with a joint ceremony.

Elite men category is only open for riders with a UCI license.

*DH Sljeme is Croatian national championship race so only Croatian riders with UCI HBS race license will receive the national championship points.

20chocolate Downhill Cup is the Slovenian Downhill Cup series. Points are awarded to riders of any federation or nationality.

REGISTRATION

Registration closes on Wednesday before the event, September 19, 2024, at 23:59. Registration is open at Prijavim.se.

Entry fee will be paid at number pick up in race office. Daily license will be available at number pick up in race office.

ENTRY FEES

Elite men, U19 men, U17 men, U15 men, Women, Master men and Amateur men: 50 EUR at preregistration and 70 EUR at late registration on site.

U13 boys/girls: 35 EUR at preregistration and 55 EUR at late registration.

The entry fee includes shuttle service on the day of the race and a hot meal after the race.

Non-licensed riders are obliged to apply for Slovenia Cycling daily license. They can enter the following categories: U13, U15, U17, U19, Amateur, Master and Women. Daily licenses will be available at number pick up in race office. The cost is 15 €.

REGISTRATION CANCELLATION

Riders should cancel their registration **by latest 12.00 on Friday** before the race. Entry fee will be returned only with a medical certificate.

PROTECTION EQUIPMENT

- Full face helmet with visor,
- Knee pads,
- Elbow pads*
- Back protector and/or neck brace (these two could be excluding each other).

*riders of Masters and Elite men categories can compete without elbow pads.

THE TRACK

The track called "DH Legends" is 1900 m long with a vertical drop of 270 m.

It is set on the North site of the Sljeme mountain, on the ski slopes of Alpine Ski World Cup where some classic downhill races have been held 15 and more years ago like the Olympus Downhill and a round of Maxxis Cup.

The start is at the top station of the chairlift Trosjedežnica. The track could be called old school with both technical and fast sections in the woods and on the ski slope, with some berms, drop-offs and jumps added in the last few years.

Unfortunately the chairlift is currently out of order so the uplift is done by a 15 min shuttle ride.

Length: 1.900 m
Elevation drop: 270 m

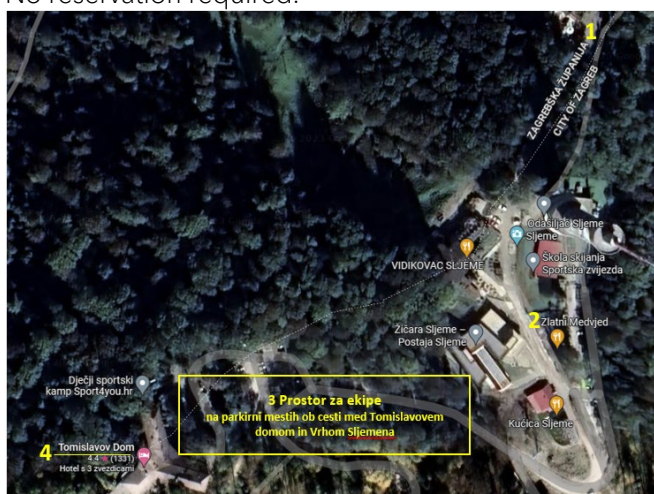


THE VENUE
